The first day of spring was March 20 and with its passing one can't help but feel a little twinge of hope that the mountains of snow will recede to be replaced by early spring flowers, and the bounty of summer vegetables.

There's no better place to find fresh vegetables, flowers and herbs than Tibbetts Family Farm.

The farm stand is located in Lyman about four miles from South Waterboro and five miles from Goodwin's Mills.

This spring, the stand will open earlier than ever before. From mid-May through the end of June, the farm will be open Friday through Sunday to sell vegetable and herb seedlings, perennials and flowers in hanging baskets and containers.

Beginning about July 1, the farm will be open every day offering fresh picked vegetables and cut flowers.

In 1988 John Tibbetts started growing

and selling vegetables with the help of his parents and children. Over the years, Tibbetts Family Farm has expanded its products to offer flowers and melons along with corn, tomatoes, cucumbers, pumpkins and much more.

The sweet corn is especially popular at the stand and many people return throughout the summer and fall to taste the new, unique varieties of yellow, white and bi-color corn as it becomes ripe. The Tibbetts family has also expanded their selection of pumpkins and fall ornaments for both retail and wholesale.

In 2001, with son Jonathan, John started offering tractor services and invested in dump trucks. They now haul manure from more than 100 horse farms and stables. During the winter months they also plow snow.

The farm grows every year, adding new products and varieties each planting season. Future plans are to build a larger farm stand with a greenhouse.
